- Identify start and end of a sentence.



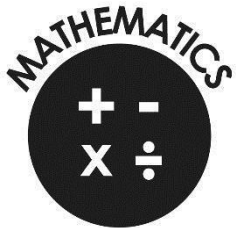
## Writing

- Use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences.
- Add finger spaces between words.
- Use correct pencil grip.
- Write name (correct upper & lower case).
- Use correct letter formation for familiar words.
- Spell tricky words correctly.



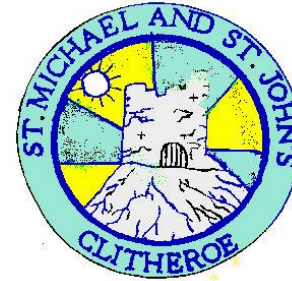
## Mathematics

- Count reliably to 20.
- Discuss the composition of numbers to 10.
- Order numbers 1 - 20.
- Say 1 more/1 less to 20.
- Add & subtract two single digit numbers.
- Count on/back to find the answer.
  
- Identify and discuss 2d and 3d shapes.
- Identify and copy patterns.
