



St Michael and St John's RC Primary School Year 6 Curriculum Overview Spring 1

English –

Older Literature – A Midsummers Night's Dream Pupils will plan and write their own scene in the form of a playscript using the characters from A Midsummer Summer's Nights Dream.

Information hybrid Pupils will be writing a non-fiction information text about their ultimate literacy villain and their best hero.

Poems with Imagery Pupils will write poems containing metaphors and personification.

Maths – This term, pupils will be looking at the following areas:

- **Measurement**
Converting metric measures
Understanding and converting imperial measures
- **Ratio**
Understanding relationship between ratio and proportion
- **Algebra**
Understanding how letters and symbols can be used as unknown values.

Science – In Science we will be focussing on the human circulatory system including the functions of the heart, blood vessels, blood and how nutrients and water are transported around the body. We will also look at the impact of diet, exercise and some drugs on the body.

TERMLY TOPIC

WWII



Geography – To be taught next term.

History – This term, pupils will be learning about World War II and will specifically be focussing on what life was like for children during this period of history. Pupils will first focus on life for evacuated children before focussing on life for Jewish children. Pupils will then create a biography/fact file about a child from World War 2.

Gymnastics – Pupils will focus on creating a gymnastics sequence using counter balances and counter tension moves with a partner.

PE – Invasion games (netball) – Coach James will be focussing on how to pass and shoot before learning attacking and defending tactics to play netball games.

Computing – Pupils will be focussing on Blogging. In this topic, pupils will be learning about the features of a successful blog, how to write a blog for an audience and understand the importance of commenting on blog posts.

MFL – In French this term we will be learning about the theme of 'clothes'.

Catholic Social Teaching – This term we will be focussing on the themes of 'Solidarity and the Common Good' and 'the Poor and Vulnerable'.

RE - Prophecy and Promise

In this branch, pupils will be learning about how the Old Testament prophecies connect with the birth of Jesus.

Galilee to Jerusalem

In this branch, pupils will be learning about Jesus' public ministry, revealing God's Kingdom through parables and teachings, calling disciples, and establishing the "new law" of love.

Design and Technology – In DT this half term, pupils will focus on mechanisms. In this unit, pupils will create a sound monitor for the classroom using computer programming devices.

Art – To be taught next half term.

Music – Pupils will be learning about musical structure and form using the Model Music Curriculum (MMC).
