



St Michael and St John's RC Primary School Year 6 Curriculum Overview Summer 1

“Following the example of Jesus,
together we learn, love and respect one
another to be the best we can be.”

English – Wonder

In this unit of work, pupils will have the opportunity to create several genres of writing including biographies, diary entries and narratives from different characters' perspectives based on the novel Wonder.

Science – In Science we are focussing on electricity. Pupils will investigate and create circuits and understand and use the correct symbols to draw them. Pupils will also problem solve tasks involving electricity and make an electrical circuit game.

PE - Athletics – Pupils will focus on skills such as running, jumping and throwing before taking part in athletic events, such as triple jump, relay races and discus.

Cricket – Coach James will be focussing on skills such as bowling, batting and the rules of playing cricket before playing games as a team.

Computing – Pupils will be focussing on creating their own quizzes as well as learning about computer can only understand the world through binary representations

MFL – In French this term we will be learning about the theme of 'at the weekend'.

PSHE and CST – We will be continuing to look at emotional and physical changes that a human goes through as they grow up. In CST, we will be focussing on 'The dignity of work'.

Maths – This term, pupils will be looking at the following areas:

- **Fractions, decimals and percentages**
Convert between fractions, decimals and percentages
Percentage of amounts
- **Area, perimeter and volume**
- **Statistics**
Bar charts, pie charts and the mean
- **Shape and geometry**
Angles and coordinates in the four quadrants

RE - Desert to Garden

In this Branch, pupils will be learning about the concepts of sin, salvation, and heaven within God's plan. We'll look at how Jesus, though fully God, experienced temptations, like in the wilderness, yet remained faithful to God's plan.

To the ends of the Earth

In this branch, pupils will be learning about the events that flowed from the Resurrection and Ascension in the coming of the Holy Spirit and the work of the apostles and early Church.

Geography – This term, pupils will be focussing on fieldwork in the local area. Pupils will learn about the eight points of a compass and six figure grid references on maps. We will also focus on reading ordnance survey maps and understanding the symbols and how rural and urban areas are shown on these types of maps.

History – To be taught next term.

Design and Technology – The theme this term is 'textiles'. Pupils will be creating their own cushion using a range of techniques.

Art – To be taught next half term.

Music – We will be using the scheme 'Charanga' and we will be learning about jazz music.
