- Working as a team



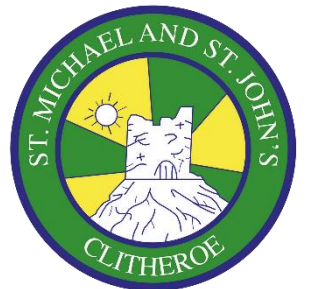
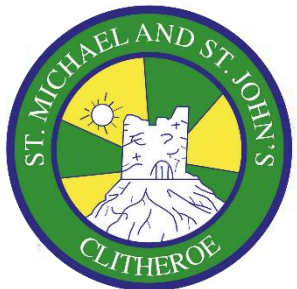
