



St Michael and St John's RC Primary School Year 6 Curriculum Overview Summer 2

“Following the example of Jesus,
together we learn, love and respect one

English – The Lion and Albert

In this unit of work, pupils will read and study the 1930's poem based in Lancashire before creating persuasive texts (adverts and reviews) and communication texts (letters and e-mails of complaint).

Science – In Science pupils will be learning about the topic of light. We will look at how light travels in straight lines from a source, how we see things and investigate shadows.

PE - Rounders – Pupils will focus on learning fielding and batting skills. Pupils will then learn and play short games.

Net and Wall (Tennis) – Coach James will be focussing on skills such as serving, different tennis strokes and playing rallies.

Computing – Pupils will be focussing on using Excel. Pupils will learn how to input data and use Excel to create graphs and how to handle and filter data.

MFL – In French this term we will be learning about the theme of 'Vikings'.

PSHE and CST – In PSHE, will be looking at how human beings are relational by nature and are called to love others in the wider community through service, through dialogue and through working for the Common Good. In CST, we will be focussing on 'Stewardship'.

Maths – This term, pupils will be looking at the following areas:

Consolidation projects

Pupils will be completing classroom based projects that revise and consolidate the maths skills taught throughout the year. The projects include:

- Being a tour operator – focus on budgeting and interpreting data
- Jobs and careers – focus on income and taxes.

TERMLY TOPIC

Pendle Witches



RE - To the ends of the Earth

In this branch, pupils will be learning about how Christians spread the message of Jesus around the world. Pupils will learn about the disciples, the work of the Church, and how faith can inspire people to help others and share good news.

Geography – Taught last half term.

History – This term, pupils will be learning about the Pendle Witch Trials. Pupils will focus on why some women were labelled as witches and how the religious beliefs of King James 1st impacted upon them. Pupils will also look at the methods and witnesses used to judge witches and forms of punishment used against them.

Design and Technology – Taught last half term.

Art – Pupils will be focusing on different types of printing based on artwork by the artist John Dyer.

Music – Pupils will be learning about chords and structure to create their own compositions.
