# EYFS- The Unseen World

### **Personal, social, and emotional development**

Children will continue to develop their relationships with a wide range of others in school. They will learn to play and work cooperatively and accepting winning and losing. They will supported to develop a growth mindset and show perseverance. In PSHE children will develop Religious Understanding, find out about personal relationships and keeping themselves safe and healthy in a range of situations. In Catholic Social teaching the themes to be explored are rights and responsibilities and stewardship.

**Mathematics** Children will reinforce the recognition of an amount just by looking at it up to 10 (using subitising). They will begin to combine sets and consolidate more and less. They will explore numbers up to 20 and share and group. Children will learn to recognise and record numerals. They will also find out more about pattern.

### **Expressive Arts and Design.**

Children will have lots of opportunities to express themselves and their learning through a variety of media. They will use natural and manmade resources. The children will explore different artists and different stimuli for developing their own ideas.

### **Understanding the World**

The children will explore the world by looking at under the sea, the Arctic and the Antarctic, and the rainforest, We will explore life cycles and the season summer. Children will explore being safe online and using ICT tools. They will use the internet to research to support their learning.

### **Physical Development**

Children will continue to develop both gross and fine motor control indoors and outdoors. In PE sessions, the children will explore athletic skills and dance. They will continue you to enhance their early games skills and develop stamina in with their skills

**R.E** The theme explored this half term is **Dialogue and encounter.** The unit introduces the idea that God loves every person and that we can learn from people who are different from us. Christians work with all people of good will and that kindness, respect, and cooperation are part of living out the Gospel. Children will explore similarities and differences between families, cultures. The unit encourages simple acts of friendship, curiosity, and welcome, helping EYFS children understand that meeting others is a gift.

**Communication and Language** Children will be provided with lots of opportunities to develop talk including extending vocabulary and developing sentence structure. They will order images from stories and events and retell or explain their understanding. They will learn to work in pairs and groups to orally rehearse and share ideas with others. They will continue to practise rhyme.

**Literacy** Children will continue to practise writing emergently and applying their phonics skills. There will be a big focus on pencil grip and forming letters correctly which develops handwriting. Children will continue to learn the phonemes in phase 3 phonics and learn to blend and segment for reading and writing. Children will learn to read and write the tricky words in phase two and three. They will experience a wide range of books being read to them and to read for themselves. A love of reading will be promoted. Children will learn to have purpose in their writing and write for a range of purposes.
