P.E

Children must have their PE kit in school, this will be sent home at the end of each half term to be washed. P.E kits must include the correct coloured house team t-shirt, dark shorts/leggings/joggers and pumps or trainers.

Water bottles

Please ensure your child has a water bottle in school. They will be able to fill up their water bottle as required throughout the school day. No juice or flavoured water.

Snack

Fruit is provided daily however, if the children wish to do so they can bring their own healthy snack to eat at playtime. Snacks **must** be healthy as we are a healthy school. Please only bring one snack per day. No biscuits, chocolate, crisps etc.

Year 2 reading books will follow our school book band scheme and will be changed when finished and signed by an adult.
