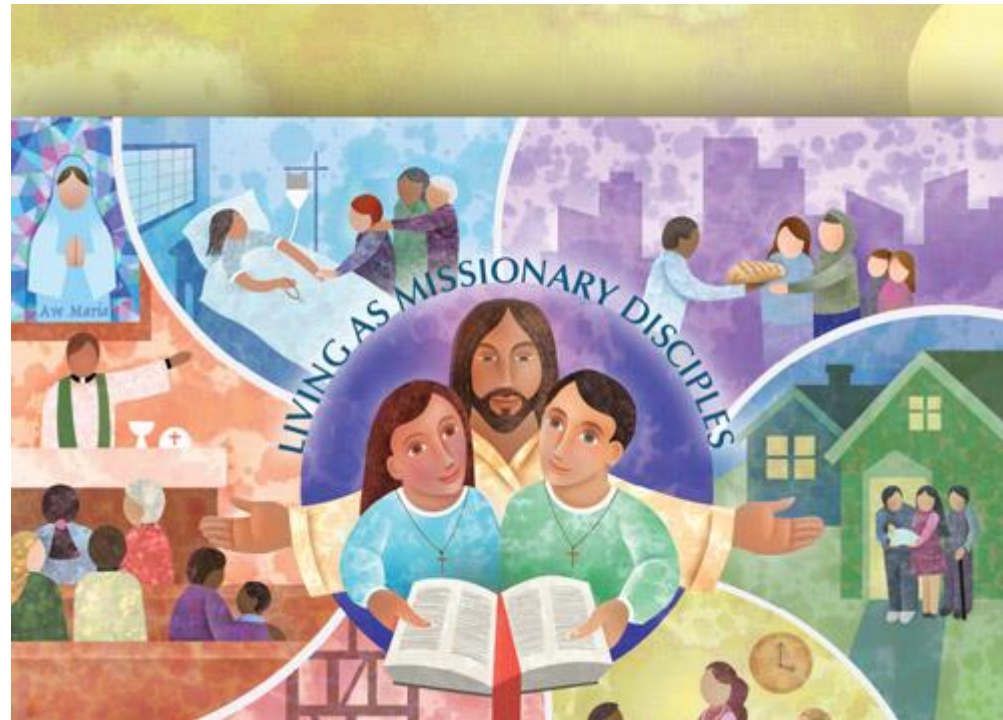
In one of our G.I.F.T. Team meetings we came up with the idea of asking Mrs Mabbott for some meditation sessions in the hall.
