

Mathematics

We will be focusing on:

- Place Value (within 100)
 - Shape

We will count forwards and backwards between 20 and 100. Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line.

We will also recognise and identify the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes.

PSHE/CST

In PSHE we will be focusing on our family and the community. We will explore different roles and jobs within the community and think about what makes a community strong. We will also learn how to keep our bodies healthy and explore how we are all unique.

(P.E)

In P.E we will be learning dance (Africa unit). The children will work together to create a simple dance routine including whole group choreography. On Wednesday's the children will continue to be taught by Burnley Football Club.

Religious Education (RE)

Our Religious studies will be based around Baptism (Signs and Symbols). We will think about welcome signs and actions during Baptism as we visit church. We will spend a week exploring another faith (Judaism), with a key focus on the Shabbat. We will then learn all about Advent and why waiting and preparing are important.

English

We are looking at Traditional Tales with a Twist. Our focus text is 'Little Red Reading Hood'. We will compare this tale to the original. The children will learn more exciting vocabulary and will write their own innovated narrative with a twist and a set of their own instructions. Y1 will continue with Phonics, using and applying lots of new letters and sounds. (Phase 5). Y2 will continue with Red Rose Spelling.

Science

In Science this half term we will be learning about animals including humans. We will identify what humans need to grow and stay healthy. We will perform simple tests to find out if there is a difference in head size between younger children and older children. We will explore the human life cycle and how we change throughout our lives.

Computing

In Computing we will be focusing on spreadsheets. The children will collect data to help answer questions. They will then learn how to input this data using rows and columns on a spreadsheet.
