

Mathematics

We will be focusing on:

- Multiplication and Division
 - Length and Height
 - Statistics

We will add to the next ten and across a ten, subtract to a ten and from a ten. We will then repeat these methods with two-digit numbers. We will also count in 2s, 5s and 10s, make equal groups, add equal groups and make arrays to support our multiplication.

Religious Education (RE)

Our Religious studies will be based around 'opportunities' during Lent. The children will learn that Lent is an opportunity to start anew. We will visit church to look at the Stations of the Cross and we will also attend Lent Mass. We will spend one week learning about Islam during 'other faiths week'.

English

We are looking at stories in familiar settings. Our focus text will be 'Sophie in the Saddle' by Dick King Smith. The children will explore a range of posters and leaflets which will inspire them to write their own. Our grammar focus will be verbs and sentence types. Y1 will continue with Phonics, using and applying lots of new letters and sounds. (Phase 5). Y2 will continue with Red Rose Spelling.

PSHE/CST

In PSHE we will be focusing on one family – one world. We will learn how people all over the world are connected and need each other. We will explore the word 'peace' and its meaning to people around the world.

Science

In Science this half term we will be learning about plants. We will identify, draw and label parts of a plant. The children will also explore the school grounds to support them when collecting and recording data linked to plants and how they grow. We will grow our own cress in different environments and compare our findings.

Music

This half term we will rehearse for our Easter performance. We will learn actions to the music that we will sing along to. The children will explore and express their ideas and feelings about music using movement, dance and expressive and musical language.

Physical Education (P.E)

In P.E we will be learning Dance –under the sea. The children will remember and perform a simple sequence of movement. On Wednesday's the children will continue to be taught by Burnley Football Club (Athletics focus).

Computing

In Computing we will be understanding the internet and searching. We will safely search the internet and share knowledge of effective searching.

Art

In Art we will be focusing on textiles (weaving). We will explore the artist Anni Albers. We will learn how to create a simple weaving pattern. The children will explore, plan and make a weaved piece in the style of Anni Albers and then be able to evaluate their final pieces.

History

We are going to be exploring the Titanic. Our enquiry question will be 'Why was the sinking of the Titanic such a significant event?'. The children will sequence events chronologically on a timeline. We will learn about what life was like onboard the Titanic and ask why and how did the 'unsinkable' Titanic sink?
