Reading

We encourage children to read a wide range of books, newspapers, reports etc to improve their vocabulary, fluency and comprehension.

Important

At the start of the year children will be listened to read and this will continue.

We expect children to be reading at home at least three times a week.



Writing

We have the expectation that everyone in year five will use a pen for writing. We will be focusing on cursive writing throughout the year and be encouraging children to use this in all of their work.

The children will cover a range of topics allowing them to use different writing formats and to become independent writers.

We want all children to understand, in school, when they write, they become authors and we want them to have that mindset going forward.

As a school we adapt the **White Rose Scheme and the advice from NCETM.**

Children are taught skills progressively and our school promotes an enquiry based approach which helps our children build key mathematical skills such as investigation, problem solving and reasoning.
