Explaining the Logistics

Wednesday 2nd July 2025:

- The children will arrive as normal to school at 8:45am.
- They will need to be dressed for activities as we will be doing one in the afternoon - a spare pair of clothes will also be needed in case the children get wet.
- Upon arrival to school, the children will drop their bags off in the school hall.
- Any medicines need to be handed over to the staff accompanying the children on the trip.
- The children must also have a packed lunch with them in a clearly labelled plastic bag.
- After registration, the children will get on the coach at 9:30am.
- You are more than welcome to wave the coach off if you wish...

Wednesday 2nd July 2025:

- We will arrive at Borwick (traffic permitting) at 11am.
- We will leave our bags in a safe and secure place before having a tour of the grounds and our lunch.
- After we have had our lunch, we will do our first activity.
- Later on in the afternoon, they will be shown to their rooms to unpack and make their beds. We will also have our evening meal.
- After a little bit of free time getting used to the building, we will do an evening activity. This will likely be orienteering.
- At around 9pm, we will come inside and have some juice and a biscuit.
- The children will be sent to their rooms at 9:30pm with lights out being around 10pm.

Additional information

- Tuck Shop – Borwick Hall has a tuck shop which we will be able to use each day after our evening meal. The children will be allowed to bring a maximum of £10 in a clearly-labelled purse or wallet. This will need to be handed in to a member of staff when bags are dropped off on Wednesday morning.

What Can You Do To Prepare...
