

Mathematics

We will continue to develop our mathematical skills by learning about:

- **Algebra** – Forming and solving equations
- **Fractions, decimals and percentages** (conversions)
- **Perimeter, areas of difference 2D shapes and volume**
- Developing our arithmetic and reasoning skills by having weekly tests.

Computing

In Computing this half term, we will finish our unit on creating our own blog.

Science

The Science unit which will take up most of this half term is called **Animals including humans**.

We will be looking at the following:

- The different parts of the circulatory system
- How the heart functions
- Investigating pulse rates
- The impact of drugs of diet on our hearts

PSHE

Our next topic will be '**Media Literacy and Digital Resilience**'. We will study a range of issues including sharing personal information online and to understand the speed at which information can be shared online.

Art

In Art this half term, we will look at **Henri Matisse and collages**. The children will be working towards creating a collage on the theme of peace linking to their WW2 History in the style of Matisse.

English

Super Sleuth: We begin our Super Sleuth unit focusing on the texts from Sherlock Holmes. We will be brushing up on our detective skills as we explore writing police reports and trying our hand at journalistic writing before we become authors ourselves creating our own super sleuth story.

French

After finishing our unit on clothes, we will then go onto a unit about School and lessons.

Religious Education (RE)

In R.E this half term, we will have two units of work. We will be looking at **Eucharist**. Our big question for this unit is, 'Why are we at our happiest when we are united?' This unit will predominantly cover the order of service in church preceding Holy Communion. Following Eucharist, we will turn our attentions to Lent. Our big question will be, '**Can any good come out of loss and death?**' This will be a poignant unit of work which will hopefully get the children to reflect about an essential part of the Church's calendar.

History

Our topic for this half term is **World War 2**. During this incredibly interesting topic, the children will base their learning around this key question: **How did World War 2 affect the lives of British and Jewish children?** Along the way, we will look at evacuation, The Blitz and The Holocaust.

Music

In Music this half term, we will be learning songs for the Easter production. We will also be looking at the unit 'what does music teach us about our community.' We will be focusing on **improving our notation skills.**
