

Mathematics

We will be focusing on:

Place Value (within 100) and shape.

We will introduce part and wholes and identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer)

Religious Education (RE)

Our Religious studies will be based around Prophecy and promise. We will learn how and why the Bible is special to Christians. We will then move onto Advent- waiting for the coming of Jesus with a focus on gifts that are important. We will also perform our KS1 Nativity in December.

English

We are looking at stories by the same author and rhyming poems. Our focus texts will be Lost and Found and How to Catch a Star both by Oliver Jeffers. The children will learn exciting vocabulary and will write their own character descriptions. Year 1 will continue phonics, using and applying lots of new letters and alternate sounds. (Phase 5). Year 2 will continue with Red Rose spelling.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be talking about how we are all created by God out of love. We will learn how everyone is unique and how boys and girls are different. We will also focus on how to keep our bodies clean and healthy.

Science

In Science this half term we will be learning about animals including humans. We will identify and name common animals. We will identify, draw and label parts of the human body. The children will also explore the school grounds to support them when collecting and recording data linked to the five senses.

Art

In Art we will be studying Vincent Van Gogh with a focus on starry night. The children will explore, plan and make a night sky painting. The children will evaluate their final pieces.

Computing

In Computing we will be focusing on pictograms and being Lego builders. The children will create their own pictograms and learn about algorithms.

Music

We will focus on the question 'How does music tell stories about the past?' The children will sing and learn different rhymes and think about the tone, pitch and voices in the music. We will also be learning songs for our Nativity.

History

We are going to be exploring our family tree. The children will explore how they have changed since they were a baby. We will study significant events that have happened in their lifetime and we will even focus on The Royal Family. We will have enquiry questions that the children will focus on each lesson.
