



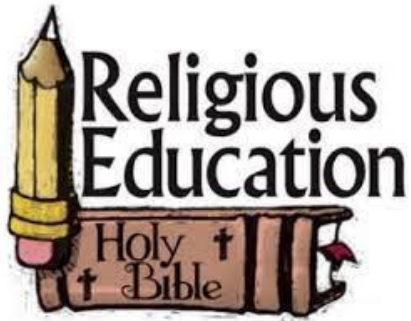
# EYFS Weekly News
