



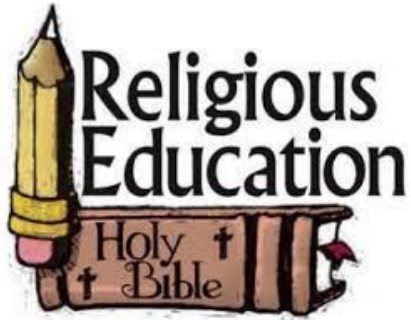
EYFS Weekly News

*This week we will be continuing our unit on Baptism. We will be acting out a Baptism and finish our drawings of the font.

Literacy:

The children will be looking at the roles of some of the jobs people do. This week we will be looking at an airport and the different roles there and the role of teachers.



PSHE/CST:

*This week we will be creating some Bonfire pictures using different media.
