



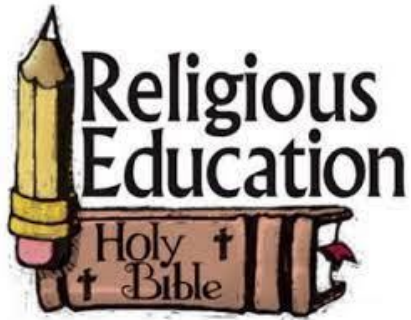
EYFS Weekly News
