



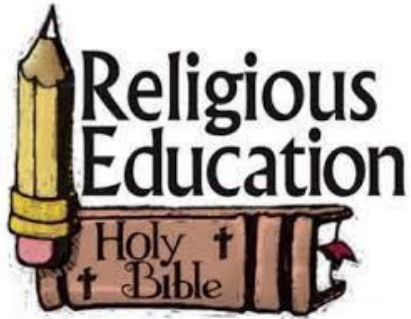
EYFS Weekly News

*This week we will be starting our RE unit on Advent which is my favourite of the year! We start by exploring birthdays and we all celebrate them.



- The children will be looking at using balancing scales and how they work moving onto using their mathematical knowledge to balance them out.



Phonics:

We will be continuing with Phase 2 looking at 'r, h, b'.

Reading:

Please read with your child nightly as these are linked to their learning so if they have not been read it means they will miss the book for that sound.

Literacy:

The children will be looking at the roles of some of the jobs people do. This week we will be looking at the mountain rescue and the role they do.



PSHE/CST:

*This week we will be looking at getting ready including how we look after ourselves – keeping clean and brushing our teeth.



*This week we will be completing some printing patterns and exploring shapes made.



*We will be looking at:

- PE – we will be looking at balancing and transferring weight from one foot to another.
- We will be looking at using our eyes to check the way is clear.



* We are continuing to look at the different jobs people do. This week we are looking at the Mountain Rescue.
