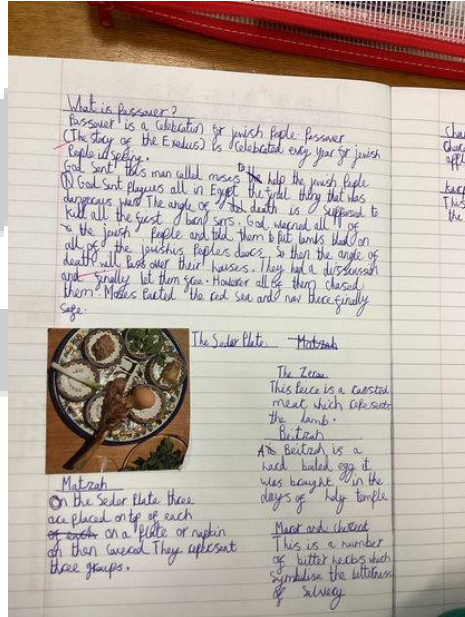

| <h1>YEAR ONE</h1> | <p>Year 1 have had a fun filled week learning about Abraham and Moses. The children have been particularly interested in how Jewish people live. We have also looked at how they celebrate Shabbat and their sacred book the 'torah'.</p> |
|  | <p>Year 2 have been learning about Shabbat (or the Sabbath as we found out it is also called). Shabbat happens each week from sunset on Friday to sunset on Saturday. During Shabbat, Jewish people remember the story of creation from the Torah where God created the world in 6 days and rested on the 7th day. We learnt all about the special weekly Shabbat meal and spotted lots of links with our own beliefs.</p> |
| <h1>YEAR THREE</h1> | <p>Year 3 have been learning about the Jewish place of worship- the Synagogue! They have been able to create their own designs of a Synagogue inserting the Star Of David on many of these. They also learnt about The Torah.</p> |
| <h1>Year 4</h1> | <p>Year 4 have had fun learning all about the Jewish sacred text called 'The Torah'. We learnt that no-one is allowed to touch it and that they use scrolls to turn the pages.</p> |



Year 5

Traditional Jewish people believe that God told Moses all of the Torah on Mount Sinai and that Moses wrote down his exact words. We had fun copying the Hebrew alphabet and seeing if we could write our own name.

In Year 5 we focused on The Passover. Children first began by researching the origin of The Passover and then focused on how it is celebrated today.



Year 6

Year 6 have looked at two key Jewish festivals this week - Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. They have made cards for the former and taken part in a scavenger hunt for the latter as shown below.
